Spiritual Growth offerings and opportunities to serve with children at BPC

“Let the children come to me, and do not stop them ...”

We at Burke Presbyterian Church take seriously our baptismal promise to welcome and nurture children in their journey of faith. Here are some of the ways in which we fulfill that promise:

Nursery (Child Care)

Quality child care by our staff, along with adult and youth volunteers, is provided for children ages 3 and younger during Sunday School and throughout worship at the Sunday morning and Sunday evening worship services.

Stepping Stones

For children ages 3 (as of the beginning of the current school year) through 5 (not yet in Kindergarten). Following the children's message in worship, children are invited to Stepping Stones for a Bible story, snack, and gently structured activities. Children are led to the Stepping Stones room at the end of the preschool hallway (room 19) and are picked up by their parents following worship.

Godly Play

Children in Kindergarten through 2nd grade are invited to Godly Play following the children's message in worship. Here we gather in a circle for story and wondering, respond to the story during “work time,” and then return to the circle for blessings and goodbyes. Children are led to the Godly Play room on the lower level and are picked up by their parents following worship.

Sunday School

This is for all ages, 3 and up! We gather each week from 10:15-11:00 am to study and enjoy, to be comforted and challenged, by the stories of the Bible and issues of our time and to connect with our community of faith. See cards in the narthex and notices in the bulletin for class descriptions and locations.

Rainbow

Children in elementary school, grades 1-6, are invited to this retreat-in-the-middle-of-the-week. Each Wednesday evening from 5:00-7:30 pm, beginning at the end of September and continuing through April, we gather for recreation, music (children's choirs), dinner, service, and Bible Study. Here we put into practice what it is to be the church and to treat one another as children of God. Parents are encouraged to participate in one way or another. Raindrops (child care) is offered for younger children of program leaders and assistants.

Raindrops

This is for younger children of program leaders at Rainbow. Our Raindrops children have dinner together and enjoy playtime, creative arts, outdoor play, and other activities. Wednesday evenings during Rainbow, 5-7:30 pm.

Receive Love. Give Love. Repeat.

OPPORTUNITIES TO SERVE AT RAINBOW

Foundational to Rainbow is the nurturing of relationships among the generations. Children develop friendships with their peers, but over the years they also get to know many adults and youth in the church — the ones who play with them during recreation, share meals and conversation at dinnertime, explore the Bible and sing and worship with them, and much more. Here at Rainbow we remember that we belong to one another and to God, and that *all of the children belong to each of us*. Church becomes an extension of family. Please note: Raindrops Child Care is available for younger children of parents who volunteer at Rainbow.

Creative Arts and Recreation (5:00-6:15 pm)

- Serve as leader or assistant on the Creative Arts Team
- Serve as leader or assistant on the Recreation Team

Bible Study Teachers (6:45-7:30 pm)

- Grades 1, 2 or 3
- Grades 4, 5 or 6

Substitute Teacher or Assistant (6:45-7:30 pm, occasionally)

- Grades 1, 2 or 3
- Grades 4, 5 or 6

Music and Worship (5:00-6:00 pm)

- Worship Assistant: support the children during Music and Worship, take roll, provide an extra set of hands.
- Assist with costumes, music direction, or stage props, etc., for the special programs led by the Rainbow children.

Family Time (6:15-6:45 pm)

- Kitchen Team: teams of 3 to 4 people prepare a set menu approximately once every 4 weeks. Team members arrive at 5:00 and are finished by 7:30 pm.
- Table Parent: typically 2 adults or 1 adult and 1 youth share a meal weekly with approximately 6 children during Family Time. Table Parents facilitate conversation, monitor table manners, and help build community among the table group.

Raindrops Childcare (5:00-7:30 pm)

- Raindrops childcare assistant, to work with our child care staff

Other ways to serve

- Setup assistance on Wednesday afternoon
- Assist/Coordinate Rainbow mission projects
- Study Hall Monitor (5:00-6:00 pm)
- Prepare and manage name tags
- Rainbow Check-in and Hospitality (4:55-5:20 pm, weekly)
- Photographer
