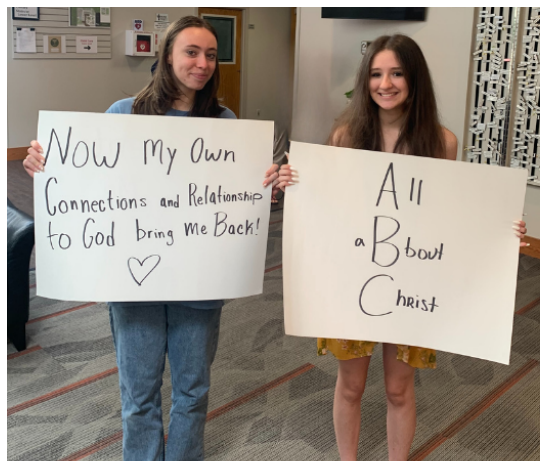
Here are some highlights:

- **Stewardship:** Use the Love One Another gifts to pay down the mortgage to decrease our overall monthly costs.
- **Mission:** Welcome our neighbors who are experiencing homelessness. We are pleased that our building will serve as a hypothermia shelter in 2024 for a week in February.
- **Congregational Care:** Connect with each other through our congregational care ministry – potlucks, picnics and fellowship over coffee.
- **Facilities:** Replace HVAC units that can no longer be repaired. Secure our building to keep each other safe.
- **Personnel:** Empower our staff to do the things that they do best – preach, worship, learn, lead.
