## 2026 Kenya Mission and Service Trip

Burke and Clifton Presbyterian churches are planning a trip to Kibwezi, Kenya in July 2026. We have had a long-term partnership with the Presbyterian Church of East Africa (PCEA), which has led to a town church, education centre, and 17 "nendeni" village churches with preschools in 6 of them. We also sponsor an orphan care program for 35 at-risk young people. There is a microfinance program closely related to our churches in the US, but separate from PCEA in Kenya.

The goals of this mission and service trip are to grow spiritually as a small, intentional group, and to strengthen relationships with Kenyan partners. The things the group will do include: work in the primary school and Polytech with students and their teachers; visit preschools; visit orphans and their extended families; and work on construction, painting, and building maintenance tasks.

As part of the trip, we will spend two nights in Nairobi upon arrival. There will be a safari to a game park with one night in a Western style hotel toward or at the end of the trip.

A typical day in Kibwezi will be:
6:00 AM time to get up
Breakfast at the Kambua Guest House
Walk to PCEA Education Centre
7:30 – devotion with Polytech students
8:00 – morning "shape up" with Imani primary school
Divide up into groups for the day

- 3-4 people go with Judy on orphan care visits
- 2-3 people go with Walking with Africans to microfinance group meetings
- 3-4 people work in Imani primary or junior secondary classrooms
- 3-4 people work on construction or painting projects

Lunch provided by Kenyan hosts, or bag lunch put together first thing in the morning After school games and reading with primary and Polytech students, possibly with some more formalized activities.

Walk back to Kambua 6:30 PM dinner 8:00 daily group devotion and discussion

Orphan care and microfinance visits will not happen every day. Work on construction or painting will depend on availability of supplies and skilled Kenyan labor.

Team building before the trip will include approximately monthly meetings with Zoom for students away at college. 16 years old is the recommended minimum age, but the group will be built by the Pastors and group leaders from all applicants. Preference will be given to college students and older teens and to those who have not been to Kenya before. We will share the list of participants by the end of January 2026.
